



## Taskforce Databuild

The Databuild course follows an earlier data workshop and data collection exercise. This training provides delegates with the knowledge and skills required to undertake an initial Taskforce Databuild and to maintain data on an on-going basis. The course concentrates on the following critical areas:

- What are the key areas of Taskforce databuild?
- In which order must the databuild be undertaken?
- How is each category of data entered into the Taskforce system?

### Who should attend?

This course is designed for individuals and teams who have, or will have, responsibility for undertaking the initial databuild and maintaining Taskforce data on an ongoing basis.

### Duration and Delivery

The Databuild course is a three-day, hands-on course, delivered in a highly interactive style. Presentations, exercises and demonstrations are used to provide an effective and enjoyable learning environment. The course is generally delivered at a customer's premises, and requires normal training room facilities, including a whiteboard, flipchart, projector and screen.

### Course Content

- Introduction to Taskforce data structures and hierarchy
- Mechanisms for data building, including bulk loading
- Building geographical data items, including maps
- Task types and importance scores
- Registering field and control users
- Creating and assigning Preferred Working Areas (PWAs)
- Creating and assigning Closed User Groups (CUGs)
- Establishing the travel model

### Training Outcomes

By attending the course, delegates will be able to:

- Undertake the initial Taskforce data load
- Maintain the Taskforce data set during live operations



## Pre-requirements

The @Road databuild workshop must have been run, and Taskforce data should have been collected and be available for loading.

A Taskforce training instance is required to deliver this course, either the customer's or the @Road training environment.

Ideally, delegates should have attended a Taskforce Foundation course. If this is not possible, an additional 'Introduction to Taskforce' module will be required at the start of the course (available as an option).
